CULTURAL ARTIFACTS

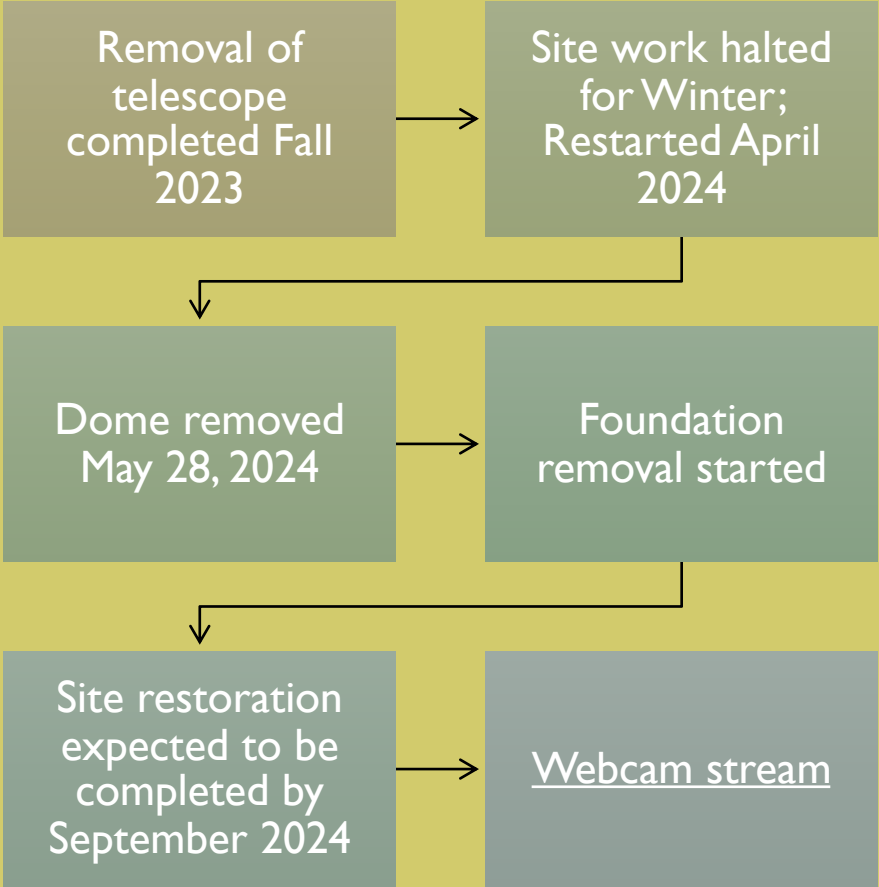
- ❖ CMS staff has been conducting due diligence on our collection of artifacts that were collected during the archaeological inventory survey in 2009. This is the survey that served as the baseline for many of our management actions to protect cultural sites.
 - ✓ This inventory is included in the repository provided to MKSOA's LT Asset Transfer WG
- ❖ Much of the material is from adze worksites on our lands and includes incomplete blanks, flakes, hammer stones, and miscellaneous leftover material. CMS has been housing this material since 2009 and except for a few items have no need to keep them further. We would like to keep some material for educational purposes but seek some other curatorship or disposition options.
- ❖ Because this material was taken from UH leased lands, the State (DLNR) technically has responsibility for this material and has final say on what should be done with the it.
- ❖ ***CMS has had preliminary communication with SHPD who have indicated a desire to transfer ownership to UH.***
- ❖ ***There are several issues with this option that CMS will be discussing with OGC, MKSOA, KKM, and SHPD.***
