ISSUANCE OF A CONCESSION AGREEMENT RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF THE RETAIL CONCESSION BY REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS DANIEL K. INOUYE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TAX MAP KEY: (1) 1-1-003: 001 (PORTION)

REQUEST:

The Department of Transportation (HDOT) proposes to issue a Concession Agreement relating to the operation of a retail concession by Request for Proposals (RFP) at the Daniel K. Inouye International Airport (Airport), as shown on Exhibit A.

LEGAL REFERENCE:

Section 102-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

LOCATION AND TAX MAP KEY:

Various portions within Terminal I and Terminal II of the Airport, Island of Oahu, State of Hawaii, identified by Tax Map Key: 1st Division, 1-1-003: 001 (Portion).

AREA:

1. Retail (Sales) Space

- a. Terminal 1, Second Level, Building 310
 - (1) Building/Room No. 310-203A, containing an area of approximately 677 square feet; and
 - (2) Building/Room No. 310-205K, containing an area of approximately 128 square feet, as shown on Exhibit B.
- b. Mauka Extension, Second Level, Building 305
 - (1) Building/Room No. 305-220, containing an area of approximately 4,140 square feet, as shown on Exhibit C.

- c. Terminal 2, Diamond Head Domestic Ext, Second Level, Building 341
 - (1) Building/Room No. 341-245, containing an area of approximately 277 square feet;
 - (2) Building/Room No. 341-255B, containing an area of approximately 1,056 square feet;

- f. Central Concourse, Second Level, Building 350
 - (1) Building/Room No. 350-217, containing an area of approximately 547 square feet;
 - (2) Building/Room No. 350-218A, containing an area of approximately 931 square feet;
 - (3) Building/Room No. 350-247, containing an area of approximately 352 square feet, as shown on Exhibit G;
 - (4) Building/Room No. 350-248, containing an area of approximately 541 square feet; and
 - (5) Building/Room No. 350-249A, containing, an area of approximately 560 square feet, as shown on Exhibit G.
- g. <u>Ewa Concourse</u>, Second Level, Building 360
 - (1) Building/Room No. 360-202, containing an area of approximately 745 square feet; and
 - (2) Building/Room No. 360-203, containing an area of approximately 611 square feet, as shown on Exhibit H-1.
 - (3) Building/Room No. 360-221, containing an area of approximately 738 square feet;
 - (4) Building/Room No. 360-222, containing an area of approximately 775 square feet; and
 - (5) Building/Room No. 360-228, containing an area of approximately 1,622 square feet, as shown on Exhibit H-2.
- h. Diamond Head Concourse, Second Level, Building 373
 - (1) Building/Room No. 373-242, containing an area of approximately 3,745 square feet, as shown on Exhibit I.
- 2. Retail Storage Space (Non-Sales)
 - a. Ewa Domestic Extension, Second Level, Building 344
 - (1) Building/Room No. 344-278A, containing an area of approximately 740 square feet, as shown on Exhibit J.
 - b. Diamond Head Connecting Link, Second Level, Building 363
 - (1) Building/Room No. 363-218A, containing an area of approximately 596 square feet, as shown on Exhibit K.

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3201, dated June 8, 1983, setting aside 3,152.177 acres designated as the Airport under the control and management of the HDOT, for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Operation and Management of a Retail Concession at the Airport.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon complete execution of the Retail Concession Agreement.

TERM:

Five (5) years.

MINIMUM ALLOWABLE PROPOSED CONCESSION FEE:

For each year of the Concession Agreement term, the total annual concession fee shall be the sum of the following:

- a. <u>Minimum Annual Guaranteed Concession Fee</u>. The minimum annual guaranteed concession fee for the first year of the Concession Agreement as set forth in the Concessionaire's Proposal, and for each year thereafter of the Concession Agreement term, 85% of the Annual Fee (the greater of the percentage fee or MAG) received by HDOT for the preceding year; or
- b. <u>Percentage Fee.</u> Twenty percent (20%) of the Concessionaire's annual gross receipts generated from, related or attributable to, or connected with the sale of merchandise authorized.
- c. <u>Upset Fee</u>. The upset MAG for the first year of the Concession Agreement shall not be less than SEVEN MILLION AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$7,000,000.00).

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The environmental impacts of the proposed action to the subject land area are covered by the Airport Master Plan Update and Noise Compatibility Program Environmental Assessment (EA), State Project No. AO1011-03. The EA is a joint State of Hawaii and Federal document, dated September 1989 and published in the October 23, 1989 issue of the OEQC Bulletin. Accordingly, relevant mitigation from the EA and HDOT environmental best management practice will address minimal impacts from this action.

REMARKS:

The successful proposer who is awarded the exclusive right and obligation to operate and maintain the Concession will be responsible for providing high quality retail offerings and services at the Airport. A high degree of experience, expertise, competence and management capability will be needed to administer, manage, operate, and provide such retail services to the traveling public. Only qualified individuals and business entities authorized to do business in the State of Hawaii and capable of demonstrating such abilities will be considered for the exclusive right and obligation to operate and maintain this Concession.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board authorizes HDOT to issue a Concession Agreement relating to the operation of a retail concession by RFP, subject to: (1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; (2) such additional terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State; and (3) review and approval of the Department of the Attorney General as to the Concession Agreement form and content.
