CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 4614, dated October 28, 2019, setting aside 883.583 acres designated as Lihue Airport to be under the control and management of the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation (HDOT) for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

RHB will use the spaces for an asphalt plant, office trailers, restroom facilities, quality control lab, parking, field office space, equipment and material staging and stock piling and storage facilities for State Project No. AK1031-14, Relocate Runway 3-21.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The HDOT has determined that the environmental impacts of the proposed tenant use for the subject land use, as shown on Exhibits A, B, and C, the subject Area and Spaces are covered by the Lihue Airport Runway 3-21 Final Environmental Assessment (FEA), published by the Office of Environmental Quality Control (OEQC) in the July 8, 2018 and the Finding of No Significant Impact was signed by the FAA on June 1, 2018. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the FEA and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month Parking Permit to RHB for land to be used for State Project No. AK1031-14, Relocate Runway 3-21 at LIH.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the HDOT recommends the Board finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month Revocable Permit to RHB, including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
