I am writing in strong support of the quitclaim of the State's interests in the road at Lualualei, Waianae; TMK: (1) 8-7-008: road. Since 2007, I have tried contacting the City and State about the status of ownership of "No Name Road." Over the decades the dirt road has been a dumping ground for vehicles and garbage. There are numerous people who are houseless that reside on the dirt road in abandoned vehicles. Drug and Criminal activity are rampant. There have been multiple attempts to clean the area, but jurisdiction and ownership always comes into play as to who is responsible for towing, cleaning, and liability.

With the request for a quitclaim deed conveying title to the 30-foot parcel of land known as the "No Name Road" located in Lualualei, Waianae, the new ownership will now be able to make future road improvements and have the authority to remove the abandoned vehicles. Additionally, the pot holes on the dirt road will be repaired which will help with vehicle and pedestrian safety.
