I am confused. I stand to be corrected but I came away from the June 28 Board meet with the understanding that the Board agreed to a 90 day extension of Blue Water Shrimp's 30-day Revocable Permit during which time Blue Water Shrimp would develop a long term proposal for BLNR's consideration based on the 2016 Ala Wai Small Boat Harbor Community Engagement Findings and Conceptual Plan and the August 2022 University of Hawai'i Vision Report. Richard Howard then proposed that DOBOR staff develop a competing proposal. The board would then set criteria by which to judge the competing proposals and rule at some point during the 90 day extension.
