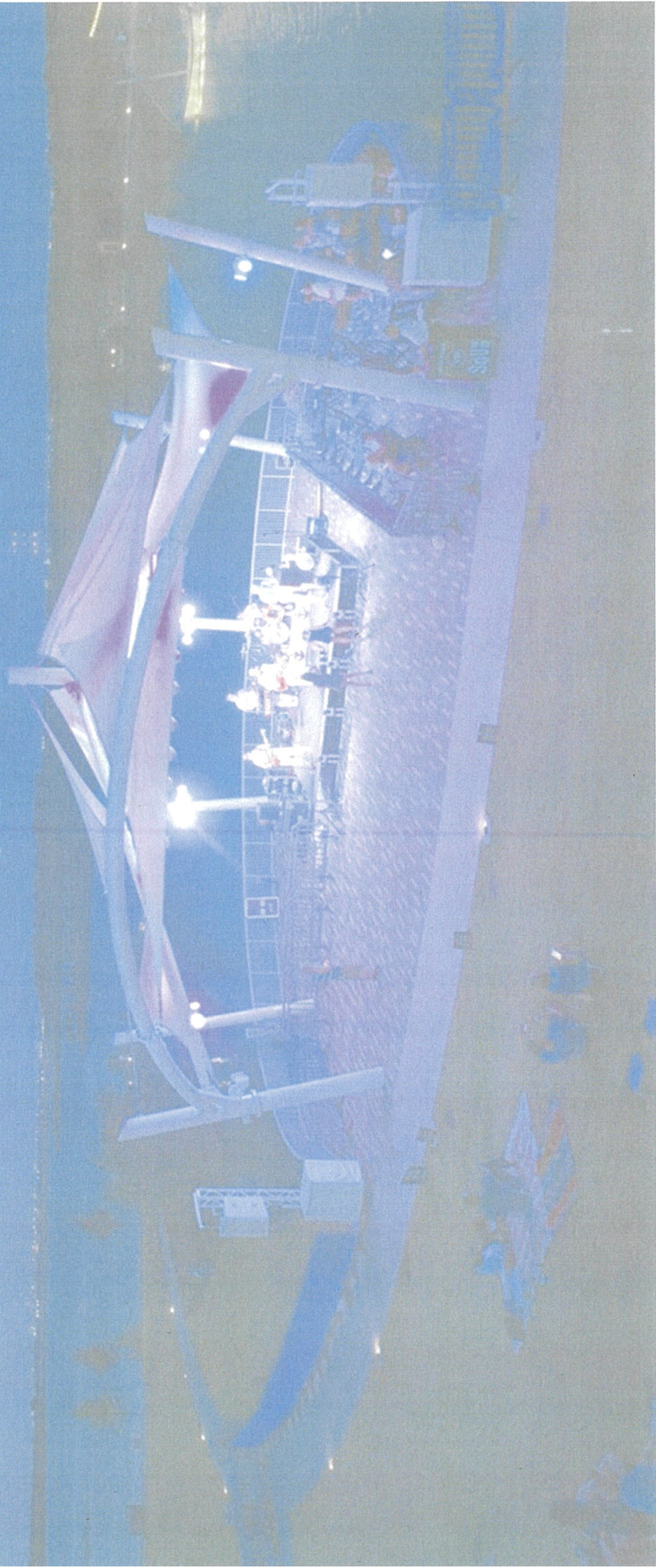

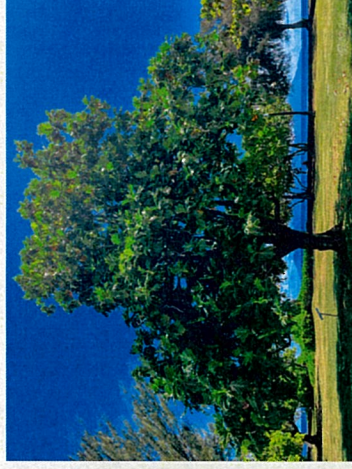
# Landscaping using Native Plants

- DOBOR met with DOFAW to discuss incorporating native plants into the landscaping design to promote local ecology, reduce water usage, and create a natural environment for the public.

- DOFAW recommended A'ali'i, 'Uala, 'Āweoweo, Loulu, Naupaka kahakai, Ti, Kukui nut tree, Milo, Kou, 'Ulu and Hala

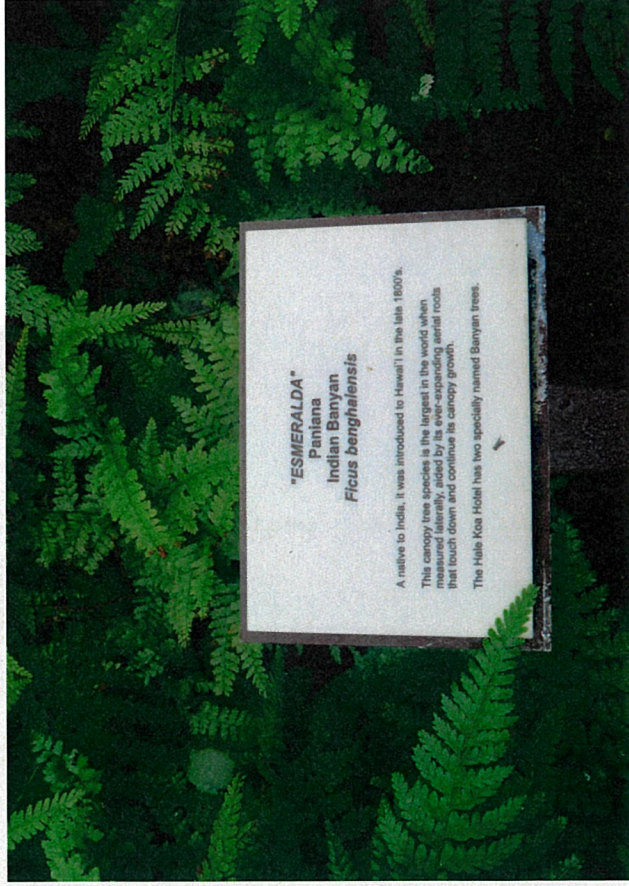
- Limit ferns (ferns need shade and lots of water)

- No palms (CRB threat), No white Tacoma



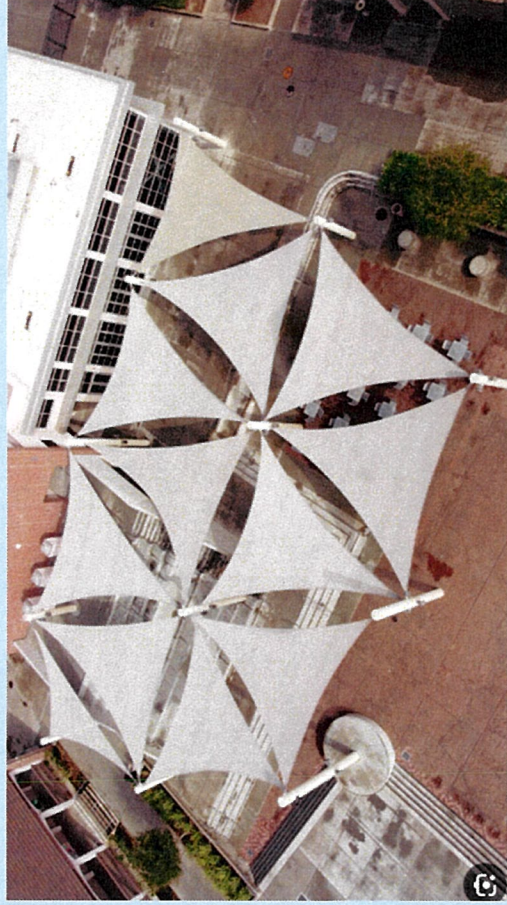
# Signage

- **Educational Value:** Signs provide visitors with information about the plants, such as their names (common and scientific), origins, and characteristics. This educates the public about plant species, biodiversity, and the importance of preserving native flora.
- **Conservation Awareness:** Highlight whether a plant is rare, endangered, or native to the area. This raises awareness about conservation efforts and the role gardens play in protecting species.
- **Cultural and Historical Significance:** Signs share information about a plant's cultural or historical relevance, especially in regions where certain plants have significance in traditional medicine, food, or spiritual practices.
- Plant signage transforms an area from a mere collection of plants into an educational, cultural, and conservation-focused experience.



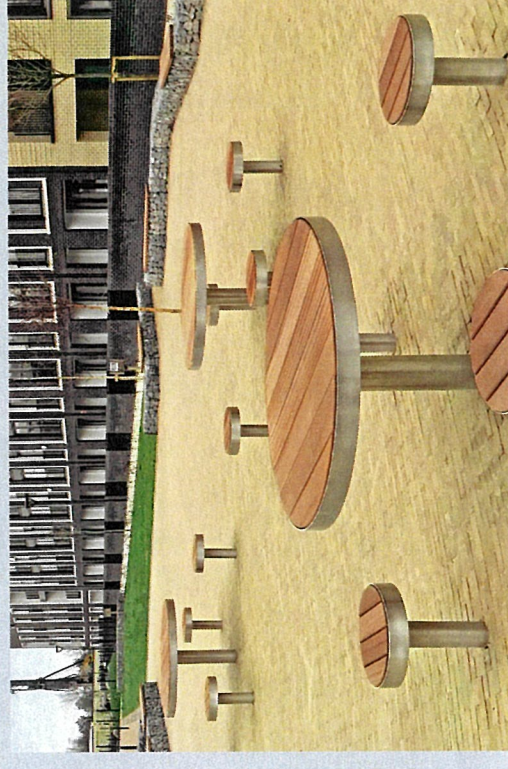
# Provide Shaded Areas

- Install shaded areas using sail shades to provide comfortable and relaxing spaces for visitors, boaters, and the public.



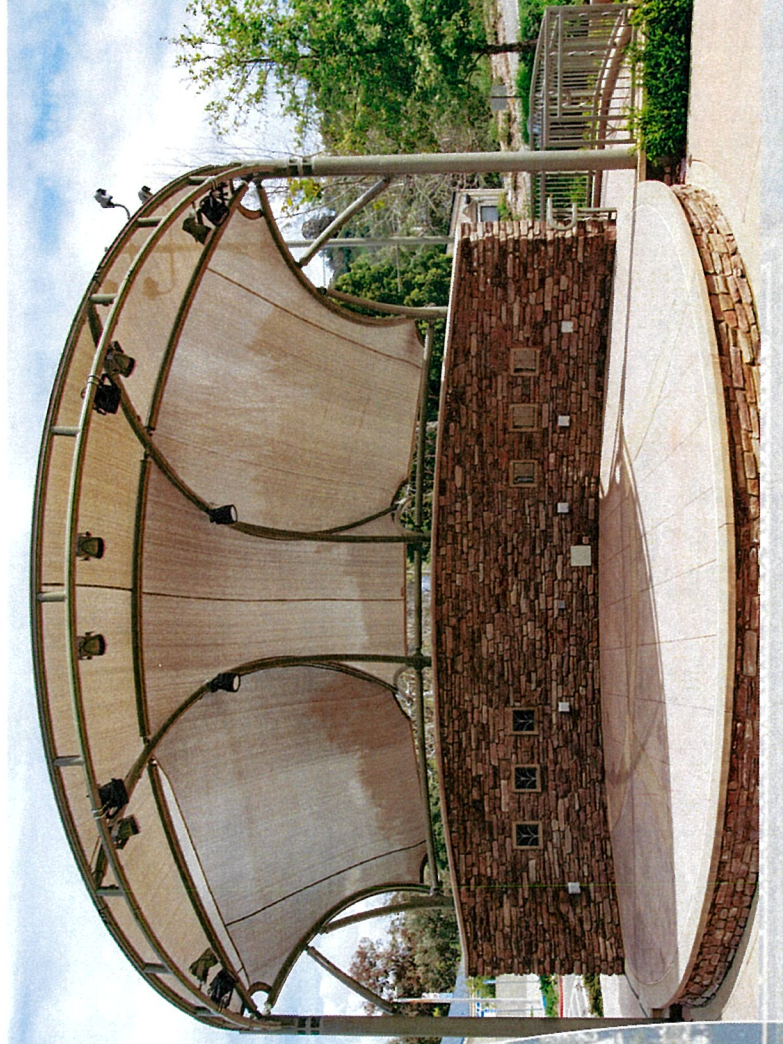
# Provide Seating

- Provide comfortable seating areas using modern street furniture to provide comfortable and relaxing spaces for visitors, boaters, and the public.



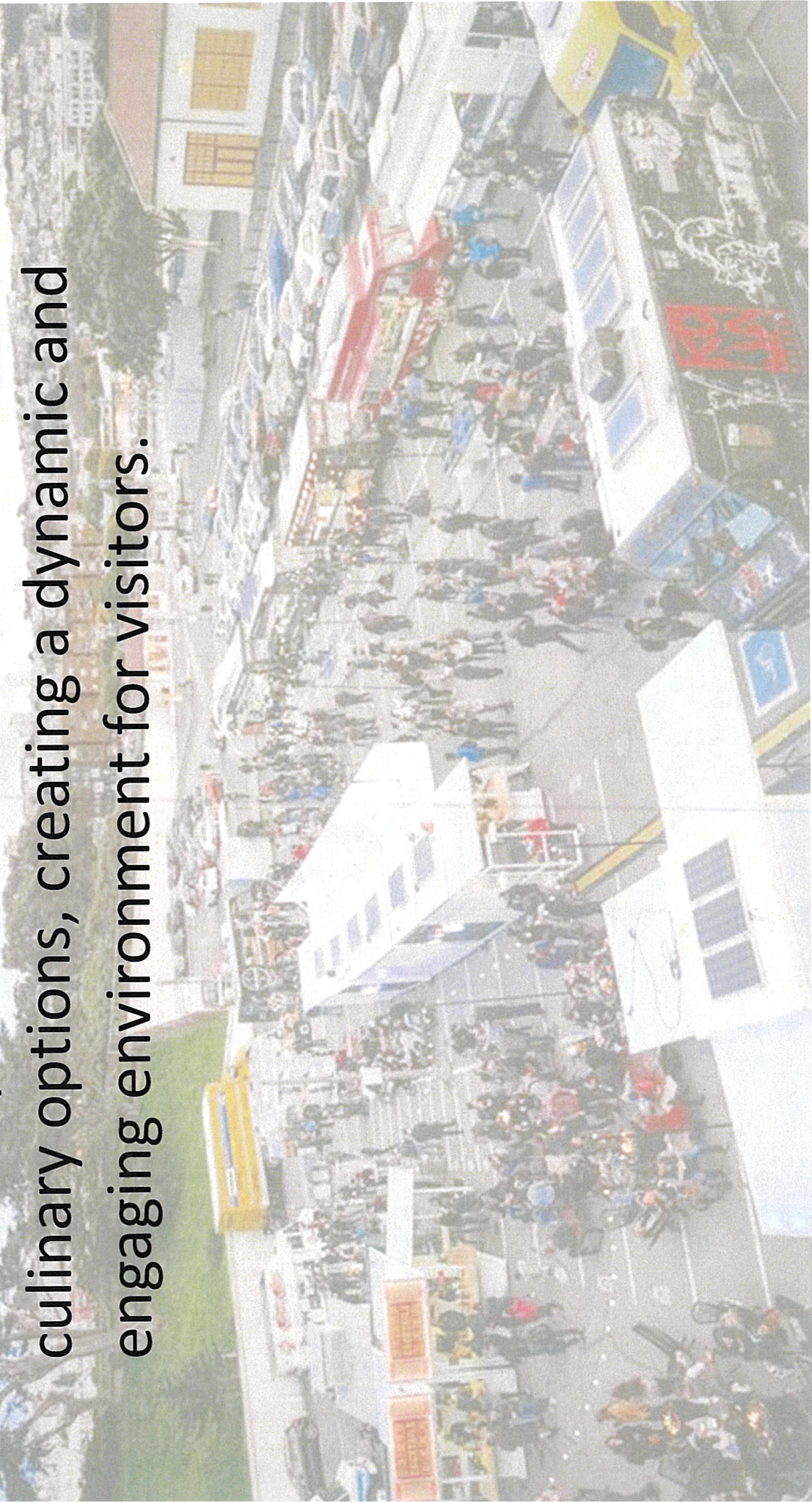
# Stage Area

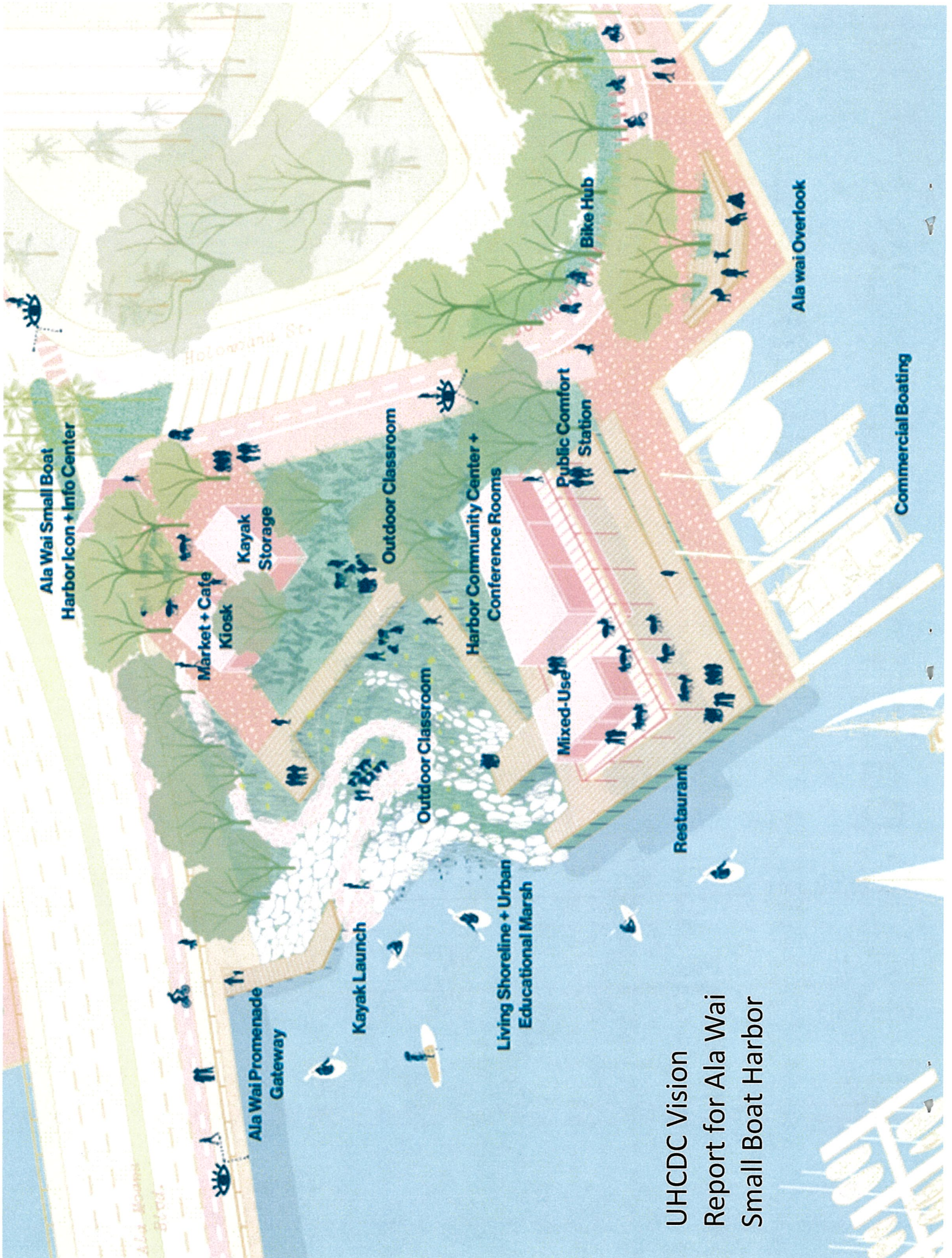
- Designate a stage area for community events, performances, and gatherings, enhancing the cultural vibrancy of the space.
