Honorable Chair and members of the BLNR, I submit written testimony in support of the creation of the new Fisheries Management Area "F.M.A." as per Chapter 48.5 proposal.

I am submitting testimony as an individual, have lived in the East Oahu area for over six decades and spent over four decades in DLNR DOCARE Oahu branch doing Conservation and Resources Enforcement field work. I have witnessed first had the decline in the near shore fisheries, particularly the herbivore fish and crustaceans.

The south shore of Oahu, i.e.the Maunalua Bay area has had the highest number of DLNR DOCARE citations issued for the taking of undersize Kala, and Uhu fish In previous years. Per citation issued, the quantity of undersize fish seized as evidence is also declining which may be equal to less fish in the same area year over year. Nearly ALL of the violations have occurred at night, while night diving using spears as the common take method.

The proposed prohibition of night diving / spearing fish, still allows the for legal take using rod and reel, surface torching methods, and legal throw nets.

NEW suggestion for consideration:

The shoreline area has 6 County shoreline parks, 1 State DOBAR small boat launching ramp, 23 public right of way shoreline access locations. Most of the shoreline access locations have a "Emergency Response Location" sign pole with a black on yellow sign indicating the location.

Recommend that DAR and / or Malama Maunalua work on a plan to install signage of the new proposed FMA.

In addition while adding same ADD text of the current area prohibition on the use of lay nets

Pursuant to 13-75-12.5 (h)(2) i.e. no lay net use within South Shore Oahu boundries.

Objective: Educate the public via up to date signage.

Goals: Gain compliance for administrative rule, and provide legal notice.
