The turtles use this beach as frequent nesting area, adding ATV and jet skis can impact the number turtle nests as well as basking turtles who also come to the beach for basking.

Light pollution if filming were to occur at tonight, noise from production crews, as well as any item left on the beach during filming can disturb the nesting cycle and cause the turtle to not lay eggs.

ATV's can run over existing nests and damage the eggs.

Monk seals frequent this beach to rest.

Please consider the species of wildlife that are protected under the Endangered Species Act and the negative impact filming will have and opt to keep the beach natural and free from unwarranted filming.
