Subject: [EXTERNAL] FORMAL OBJECTION: Construction Award and Fiduciary Breach - TMK: 1-4-1-008:080

Attention State Officials,

I am writing to formally object to the construction award and any pending "Notice to Proceed" for the **Hui Mahi'ai 'Āina expansion and Direct Lease to Mahi Ai Developer LLC approved by BLNR on February 13, 2026 under item M-1**. As a lineal descendant of **Lunalilo, Keawekane, KaluaOpele, and Keawe-mauhili**, and an active **DHHL beneficiary** on the waitlist, I am providing notice of a continuing **Breach of Fiduciary Duty**.

1. **Improper Standing Denial:** I was the Petitioner at the BLNR (Oct 11, 2024, Item D-6). The Board's denial of my standing is factually incorrect; as a royal descendant and homeless beneficiary, the diversion of this land for a private entity is a direct injury.
2. **Lack of Due Process:** The use of an **Emergency Proclamation** to bypass **HRS 343**(Environmental) and **HRS 6E**(Historical) reviews on my ancestral lands violates the State's constitutional mandate.
3. **Active Harm:** I have identified at least two existing residents experiencing negative impacts from this expansion.

I demand a stay of all construction awards until a formal **Beneficiary Consultation** is completed.
