Delegation of Authority to the Chairperson to: (1) Procure, Award and Enter into Professional Services Consultant Contracts for Capital Improvement Program Projects and Operating Budget Projects Funded by the Legislature (as Listed in Exhibit 1) or Operating Funds; (2) Declare a Construction Project Exempt from the Preparation of an Environmental Assessment, or Approve an Environmental Assessment and Issue a Finding of No Significant Impact, if Appropriate; and (3) Approve, Procure, Award and Enter into Goods, Services, and Construction Contracts for Capital Improvement Program Projects and Operating Budget Projects Funded by the Legislature (as Listed in Exhibit 1) or Operating Funds

The Engineering Division and other Departmental Divisions desire to implement and execute Capital Improvements Program (CIP) and/or Operating Budget Projects by engaging consultants to provide various professional services and contractors to perform necessary work. CIP projects may include, but are not limited to, those identified and described in Exhibit 1. Operating Budget projects may include, but are not limited to, repair and maintenance, emergency response, hazard mitigation, regulatory compliance (e.g., dam safety, mineral resources), and other work required for administrative, programmatic, or land management purposes. The list is organized by division and the Program ID under which the funds were appropriated.

DISCUSSION:

The Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2026 and other appropriations for which funds have not lapsed, authorize the expenditure of funds for various projects. Operating funds are provided through all means of financing.

The implementation of projects will comply with Budget Execution Policies issued by the Governor through the Department of Budget and Finance.

All procurements will be conducted in accordance with the State Procurement Code, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) Chapter 103D. Professional services consultants will be procured pursuant to HRS Chapter 103D-304 (Professional Services), and contracted to perform feasibility or planning studies, design work, or other related services. We

respectfully request that the Board delegate authority to the Chairperson to approve, procure and enter into contracts for such professional services.

All projects will comply with the applicable provisions of HRS Chapter 343, and Title 11, Chapter 200.1, Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) regarding environmental impact statements. We respectfully request that the Board delegate to the Chairperson the authority to declare applicable projects exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment (EA), or to approve an EA and issue a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for projects in which an EA is prepared and such findings are warranted. In accordance with the HAR, each agency must submit exemption notices and EA/FONSI determinations to the State of Hawaii Office of Planning and Sustainable Development's Environmental Review Program for publication in its periodic bulletin. All projects for which an environmental impact statement (EIS) is prepared will be presented to the Board for review and consideration.

Goods, services, and construction will be procured in accordance with HRS Chapter 103D. We respectfully request that the Board delegate authority to the Chairperson to approve, procure and enter into contracts for such projects that do not require an EIS.

We also request that the Board authorize the Chairperson to sign supplemental agreements for professional services, goods, services, and construction contracts, and to enter into and execute any other documents or agreements, including but not limited to, rights of entry or permit applications, related to the implementation of the projects, if necessary and appropriate.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. That the Board delegate authority to the Chairperson to procure, award and enter into professional services consultant contracts and, if necessary, supplemental agreements, in accordance with HRS Chapter 103D for various projects that are funded with CIP funds (as listed in Exhibit 1) or operating funds, and to enter into and execute any other documents or agreements to implement the approved projects, subject to available funding, release of funds by the Governor, and review and approval as to form by the Department of the Attorney General.
2. That the Board delegate authority to the Chairperson to declare applicable projects covered by this request exempt from the preparation of an EA or to approve an EA and issue a FONSI, if appropriate.
3. That the Board delegate authority to the Chairperson to approve, procure, award and enter into goods, services, and construction contracts and, if necessary, supplemental agreements, in accordance with HRS Chapter 103D for the various projects that are funded with CIP funds (as listed in Exhibit 1) or operating funds, and to enter into and execute any other documents or agreements to implement

the approved projects, subject to available funding, release of funds by the Governor, and review and approval as to form by the Department of the Attorney General.

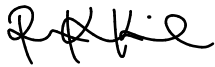
